As we begin 2012 a Happy New Year to all SAL members, and we look forward to seeing you at our next meeting on Tuesday, January 3rd 2012.

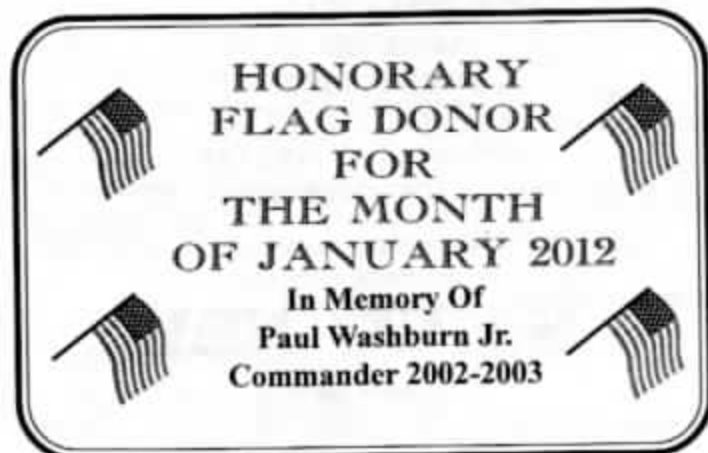
Our thoughts and prayers are with Rick Tacy who continues to recover at Pinebrook. Rick's father and Post member Charles passed to the Post Everlasting last month.
