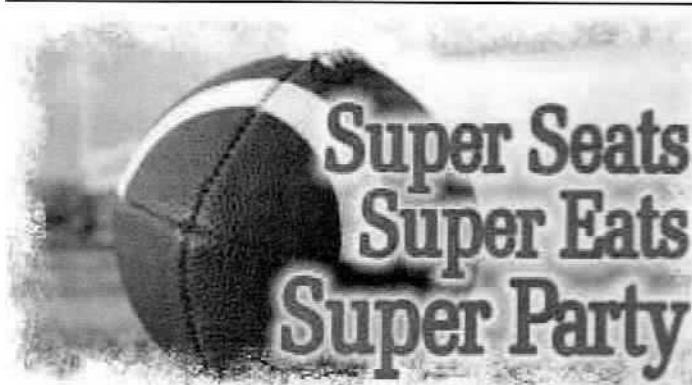

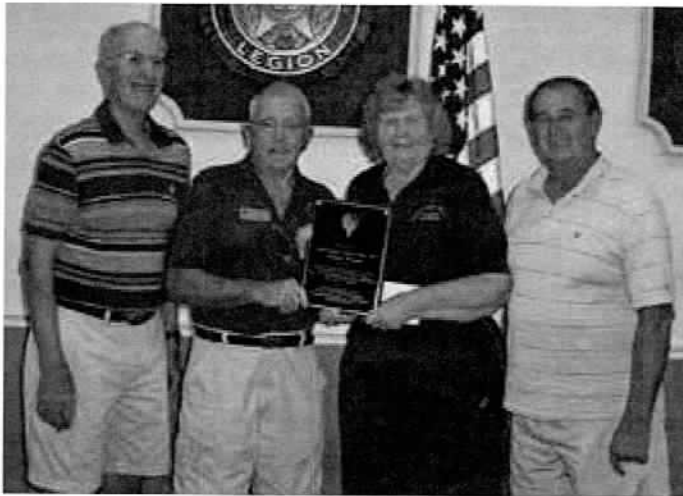

## S.A.L. ADJUTANT MESSAGE

Several weeks ago NO-VEL Squadron 159 celebrated 38 years of being chartered by the Detachment of Florida. The Constitution and By-Laws submitted to the Detachment last year were approved by the Post, Department and Detachment in August without a single correction or revision by the leadership.

Over the years the Squadron has grown to a proud standing of #1 within the 8<sup>th</sup> District and one of the largest in Florida. We are pleased to note currently that with 50% of 2014 fiscal year now history, our membership is nearly 75% of assigned goal. 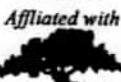
